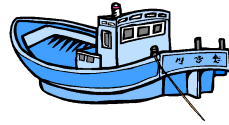
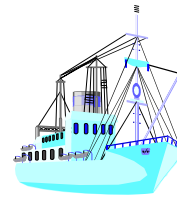

FROM ROUTE #47:

Take 47S to Bayshore Rd (light with Texaco station on far right corner). Turn right at light. At blinking light, bear left 90 degrees. At 4th light bear right. At 2nd light make right onto Town Bank Road. Town Bank Fire Hall is about 1/2 mile on the left and well-marked.
